

NAFI HEADQUARTERS KALAMAZOO MI: NAFI is proud to announce the hot air balloon Elite Balloon Instructor (EBI) program fueled by National Association of Flight Instructors (NAFI). The Balloon Training Academy, a 501c3 nonprofit organization dedicated to hot air balloon education and training, approached NAFI with a unique idea. All hot air balloon commercial pilots can act as Certified Flight Instructors since the fundamentals of instruction are part of a balloon commercial rating, however there is no specific CFI rating and no re-currency/renewal training required to maintain flight instructor privileges.



Adam Magee, President of The Balloon Training Academy sought out NAFI support on the project, "Given NAFI's success in its mission to promote a high level of professionalism among aviation educators and recognition for their contribution to aviation, safety, education and training, The Balloon Training Academy reached out to NAFI to partner in developing the Elite Balloon Instructor Program."

The Elite Balloon Instructor Program designation represents a differentiation between a commercial balloon pilot acting as a CFI and one who demonstrates the highest level of instructional activity, educational experience, and professional service to the flight training community while acting as a CFI. The recognition program is modeled after the NAFI Master Certified Flight Instructor program.

John Niehaus, NAFI Director of Program Development played a key role in guiding BTA through the development of this program. "The EBI is a perfect way for us to help the lighter-than-air community and lend our expertise to further promote professionalism among **all** aviation educators," said John. He added, "I believe NAFI members can also benefit from the unique perspectives brought by this group of aviators."
