Professional Development Program Overview

n line with the National Association of Flight Instructor's (NAFI) mission to improve and maintain flight instructors' professionalism and in recognition of its 50th anniversary NAFI will launch the NAFI Professional Development Program (PDP) at AirVenture 2017.

The NAFI PDP is a means of providing all CFIs with invaluable education and tools to enhance their technical and teaching skills including improving their ability to interact with students so that more reach their goal to become a pilot.

NAFI will host the first of many PDP initiatives at AirVenture in the Professional Development Center (PDC). The Center will feature; a 50 seat theater for presentations by NAFI members for CFIs; a simulator classroom with four Precision Flight Controls AATDs for real-life scenario-based sim training for CFIs; and a Mentorship Cafe for networking with fellow members, NAFI staff and board members.

Several of the presentations will broadcast on FAASTeamTV. These WINGS approved presentations will be archived for viewing by all pilots at www.faasafety.gov.

The demand for professional pilots over the next several years may materially outpace the supply. Many aviation organizations, associations, manufacturers and suppliers of flight training materials have instituted campaigns to address this issue. These programs have proven to increase interest in learning to fly and generate quality leads for flight schools and independent instructors. However, research shows that upwards to 80% of student pilots who start flight training dropout before earning a certificate. Other than the commonly known issue of cost, challenges with the flight instruction process are most often cited as the reason for not continuing to pursue a pilot's certificate. Poor quality instruction, lack of structured training, consistency and professionalism, weak consideration for learning styles, a perceived lack of commitment to the student's success and poor customer service can all be factors in discouraging individuals from learning to fly¹.

NAFI plays a vital role in the efforts of industry colleagues who tirelessly develop interest in flying, to make sure people complete flight training. The Professional Development Center educators will be NAFI members, industry leaders, designated pilot examiners, the FAA and other stakeholders in growing and sustaining the pilot population. No other organization represents flight instruction like NAFI does. With a 50-year track record, NAFI is well positioned to reach CFIs across a wide spectrum.

The NAFI PDP is an ongoing effort to improve flight instruction in order to train more pilots and better pilots.

Detailed Overview of the

NAFI Professional Development Program

Flight instructors are on the front line of pilot development serving as the "distributer" of knowledge and service to students. To be proficient, CFIs need a unique set of skills. The NAFI Professional Development Program provides access for CFIs to the skills they need to enhance their instructional proficiency - for initial certification, periodic review, and continuing education.

The NAFI PDP will provide education in five major subject areas: Physical/Psychological, Legal/Insurance, Business Skills, Technique and Regulatory.






